To bring the province to reduce, reuse and recycle all kind of waste in a circular way and help reduce climate change.




What are the results for C&D waste?

 ✓ Porcelain






C&D Waste are not

Origin of C&D waste









 - Periodics waste characterization
 - Characterization at C&D sorting facilities
